- Rio+20 The Future We Want "Water is at the core of sustainable development as it is closely linked to a number of key global challenges"
- UN online consultation The World We Want with water as one of thematic areas
- Results of the consultations key input to High Level
  Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015
- Report submitted to UN General Assembly in May
  2013
- Budapest Water Summit in October 2013



## **Open Working Group**

- UN Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals
- African Group, Asia Pacific Group, Latin America and Caribbean
- Western Europe and other group (The Netherlands/UK, Denmark/Ireland/Norway, Italy/Spain/Turkey), Eastern European Group (Hungary, Belarus/Serbia, Bulgaria/Croatia, Montenegro/Slovenia, Poland/Romania)
- Focus area 6: Water and sanitation (11th Session)



#### **National consultations**

- DANIDA the European Union Water Initiative Africa Working Group and UN-Water
- Regional and Country Water Partnerships
- February April 2014
- Second round brought together 1,200 participants from 29 countries
- Bulgaria, Poland, Romania and Slovenia



## **Key messages**

- Consensus on the need for a dedicated water goal within the post-2015 sustainable development framework
- The proposed goal of "Securing sustainable water for all" fits with national development priorities
- Strong support for a comprehensive and integrated view of water in the post-2015 development framework
- Need for clear definitions of terms and indicators



## **Implementation**

- Institutions will need to be strengthened to deliver results across the broad spectrum of water and related areas
- New implementation pathways, including greater stakeholder participation - youth and women
- New and existing infrastructure and related investments
- New technology is seen as playing a crucial role in implementing the SDGs and in achieving water security
